



Houston Sailing Association 2026 Sailing Education

WELCOME: Houston Sailing Association (HSA) is sponsoring its 22nd annual Sailing Education Program at Acton Lake in Houston Woods State Park. HSA members will be available to provide instructional lessons. HSA is a welcoming club that introduces interested individuals to the sport of sailing.

THE INTRO TO SAIL: HSA offers three introductory sailing education sessions during the sailing season, offering the classes in June, July, and August. The initial class #1 (June 6th) runs approximately from 10:45 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., depending on Mother Nature. After the kickoff lesson, the objective is to schedule two follow up dates with favorable wind to go out again. Skippers will be assigned to lessons #1, #2 and #3. Lessons include on- and off-water instruction on safety, wind/weather awareness, rigging, launching, and sailing. HSA is a safety-minded club and will provide experienced instructors, sailboats, and life jackets. Bringing your own life jacket is welcome. Classes take place at the Houston Woods State Park Marina. Mother Nature determines the weather and the amount of time on the water for any given lesson, so makeup dates will be arranged if necessary to keep everyone safe. June's session: Saturday, June 6th, with follow-up lessons #2 & #3 to be completed anytime within the four weeks from June 6th; July's session: Saturday, July 18th, with follow-up lessons #2 & #3 to be completed anytime within four weeks. August's session: Saturday, August 15th, with follow-on lessons #2 & #3 to be completed anytime within four weeks.
